## General Information

---

**Purpose** This document tells you how to install additional courseware, courseware add-on licenses, and/or system licenses on your PLATO Pathways system.

---

**Requirements** In order to install additional courseware, courseware add-on licenses, and/or system licenses, you must meet the following requirements:

- You have the latest version of PLATO Pathways system software and courseware installed.
  - Your workstations are set up and configured to run PLATO courseware.
- 

**Caution** You can install your additional courseware, courseware add-on licenses, and/or system licenses on either a standalone or networked workstation. However, do not install additional courseware or courseware licenses directly onto a network file server.

---

**Materials** Besides this document, you will need the following in order to install additional courseware and/or system licenses:

- Pathways Courseware/License Install Disc (located behind the *Additional Courseware or Licenses* tab in your kit)
- PLATO Courseware CD-ROMs (located behind the *Courseware Upgrade Materials* tab in your kit).

**Note**

It may be necessary for you to verify the versions of courseware that you have already installed. See **Appendix A** at the end of this document for more information on how to use the PLATO® Pathways Activity Version Utility.

---

**Duration** The amount of time it takes to install additional courseware and/or system licenses depends on the amount of new courseware you are adding to your system and the speed of your CD-ROM drive.

## Installing Additional Courseware and/or System Licenses

---

**Introduction** Follow these instructions to install additional PLATO Pathways courseware, courseware add-on licenses, and/or system licenses.

---

**Before you begin** To prepare for the installation, follow the steps below.

Step	Action
1	Back up your PLATO Pathways folder (PWAY) and all its contents.
2	Close any applications running on your desktop including screen saver, antivirus software, and workstation security programs.

---

**How to** To install additional courseware and/or system licenses, follow the steps below.


Step	Action								
1	If you are running this installation in a network environment, log on through your workstation to the network with administrator rights to the PLATO Pathways folder on your file server and workstation. You must be logged on to the workstation with administrator rights.								
2	Sign on to PLATO Pathways as an administrator. <table border="1" data-bbox="565 1276 1386 1470"><thead><tr><th>Step</th><th>Action</th></tr></thead><tbody><tr><td>1</td><td>Enter <b>administrator</b> for your PLATO name.</td></tr><tr><td>2</td><td>Enter <b>admin</b> for your password (or the administrator's password you are using).</td></tr><tr><td>3</td><td>Click <b>Continue</b>.</td></tr></tbody></table>	Step	Action	1	Enter <b>administrator</b> for your PLATO name.	2	Enter <b>admin</b> for your password (or the administrator's password you are using).	3	Click <b>Continue</b> .

6	Click the <b>Install Courseware</b> button.  <b>Result</b> The Select Package to Install dialog box displays.
7	Navigate to your CD-ROM drive to display the contents as shown below. <div data-bbox="548 835 1409 1476" style="border: 1px solid black; padding: 5px; margin-top: 10px;">  </div>

All of these options may not display depending on what you are adding and/or upgrading.





13	<p>Insert the PLATO Courseware CDs as you are prompted for them.</p> <p><b>Tip</b> You can find the CDs behind the <i>Courseware Upgrade Materials</i> tab in your kit.</p> <p><b>Result</b> When the courseware installation process completes, the system returns you to the Courseware tab.</p>
14	<p>Select the <b>Install Courseware</b> button on the Courseware tab and repeat steps 7-13 if you have more than one curriculum to install. You are finished performing a normal courseware installation.</p>
15	<p>Review the listed courseware for which to perform a custom installation.</p> <p><b>Note</b> By default each courseware package is selected. The checkmarks indicate the courses for which you want to select a specific installation location. Deselect any courseware packages you do not want to install to a specific location.</p>



21	<p>Repeat steps 15-20 to select custom locations for additional courseware, as applicable.</p> <p><b>Tip</b> After each custom installation, check the Space Required information on the Custom Courseware Installation window. If this number is negative, contact your system administrator to free up more disk space or deselect courseware until you have enough space.</p> <p><b>Note</b> Some workstations in Novell networks may not be able to detect more than 2 GB of free space. On these systems, run the courseware installation multiple times and limit the installation to less than 2 GB each time</p>
22	<p>Insert the PLATO Courseware CDs as you are prompted for them.</p> <p><b>Tip</b> You can find the CDs behind the <i>Courseware Upgrade Materials</i> tab in your kit.</p> <p><b>Result</b> When the courseware installation process for this set of CD-ROMs completes, the Courseware tab displays all the courseware titles included in this set.</p>
23	<p>Click the <b>Install Courseware</b> button and repeat steps 15-22 if you have more than one curriculum to install.</p>
24	<p>Exit PLATO Pathways and return to the Windows desktop.</p>
25	<p>Remove the Courseware/License Install CD-ROM from your CD-ROM drive. The installation is complete.</p>



## Installing User Licenses

**Introduction** The number of user licenses determines how many users may be logged on to PLATO Pathways at the same time. The user licenses are provided on the Courseware/License Install CD, and must be installed before users will be able to access PLATO Pathways.

---

**How to install user licenses** To install user licenses, follow the steps below.

---

Step	Action
1	Insert the Courseware/License Install CD.
2	Sign on to PLATO Pathways as an administrator.
3	Go to <b>System Management</b> , and open the <b>Courseware</b> tab.
4	Click the <b>Install Courseware</b> button.
5	Navigate to the <b>UserLmt.lic</b> file on the courseware installation CD.
6	Click <b>Open</b> .  <b>Result</b> A message stating “License Installation was successful” displays.
7	To verify that user licenses were installed, click <b>Help</b> above the blue “Exit” door, and select <b>About</b> . A dialog box will display and “User License: #” will reflect the number of user licenses installed, for example, “User License: 30.”

## Appendix A: Using the PLATO® Pathways Activity Version Utility

**Introduction** It is important to know whether you have the latest versions of courseware available to you, and what versions of courseware you currently own, in the event you need to reinstall certain courseware or request courseware upgrades. The PLATO Pathways Activity Version Utility provides a list of all courseware you currently have installed and includes the version number for each title.

---

**Products affected** PLATO Pathways version 4.3.

---

**How to run the Activity Version Utility** To run the Activity Version Utility, follow the steps below.

---

Step	Action
1	From a workstation, open the <b>PWAY\BIN</b> folder.
2	Locate the <b>ReadCWver.exe</b> file and double click the file to launch the Activity Version Utility.
3	Click the <b>Run</b> button to start the utility.  <b>Result</b> The program automatically locates the Pathways system to which the workstation is connected and displays a list of all main courseware titles installed on the system. All listed courseware titles include the title of the Pathways courseware CD on which the courseware was originally distributed. The CD title contains the most recent courseware version.
4	The information is displayed in columns. You can click the heading of any of the columns to sort by that column's properties.
5	You can save this information by clicking the program's <b>Save</b> button and selecting a location on your local hard drive. To open the file after it has been saved, you must choose to open it with a Microsoft®-based application, such as Microsoft® Excel.
6	To close the program, click the <b>Close</b> button, or use the <b>X</b> in the upper right corner of the window.
